The City of Sacramento proposes to update to the 2011 River District Specific Plan (Plan). The proposed River District Specific Plan Update will serve as a forward-looking policy and regulatory document that will guide land use, development, infrastructure planning, and public investment in the River District over the next 10- to 20-year planning horizon.

The City is the Lead Agency responsible for preparation of a Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) for the proposed Plan update. The SEIR will evaluate potential significant environmental effects of the proposed Plan. Written comments regarding the issues that should be covered in the SEIR, including potential alternatives to the proposed Project and the scope of the analysis, are invited.

The City will hold two scoping meetings regarding the proposed Plan update. Responsible agencies and members of the public are invited to attend and provide input on the scope of the SEIR. The scoping meeting will be conducted in a virtual open house format. Written comments regarding relevant issues may be submitted during the meeting.
